Nearest Car Parks

Wembley Park is offering your first 3 hours of parking in the Red car park free of charge when you validate your ticket at any BOXPARK bar and show a valid BOXPARK Black Card.

What to Wear

We want you to be moving! So arrive in any active-wear you're comfortable in!

Bag Drop

You will receive a number on your wrist band as you sign in. You will also receive a tag with the same number to attach to your bag and handover to our staff where we can look after your items as you enjoy your run. Bag collection will close by 13:15 as we move over to BOXPARK so please collect your bag quickly after the run.

Run Results

With this event not being about achieving a personal best there won't be any chip times, however we will be completing the RUN THE ENDS Strava Challenge where you can click in your 5km Run.

Pacers and Volunteer support

The dream team of volunteers and pacers are back again, they will be supporting you through the route to ensure nobody gets left behind and to that finish line. Look out for the pacers joining you in the start pen wearing bright tops. Expect to see at least two pacers for each group from run to run/walk pace.

Course Marshals

Marshals wearing hi-vis vests will be positioned at regular intervals along the route and are there to help you if needed.

Both male and female toilet facilities are located within Brent Civic Centre and BOXPARK.

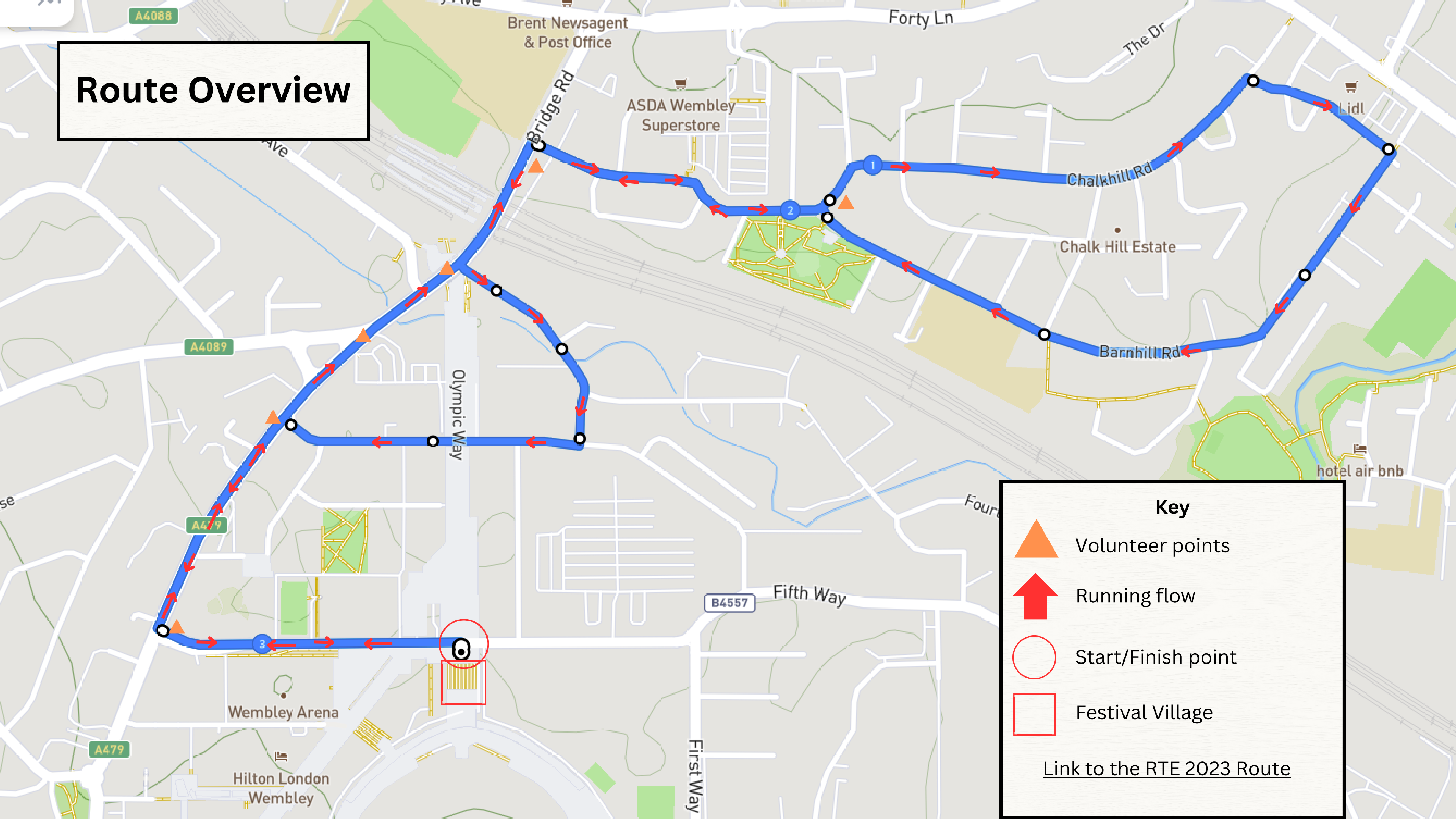
Media Team

Route Overview

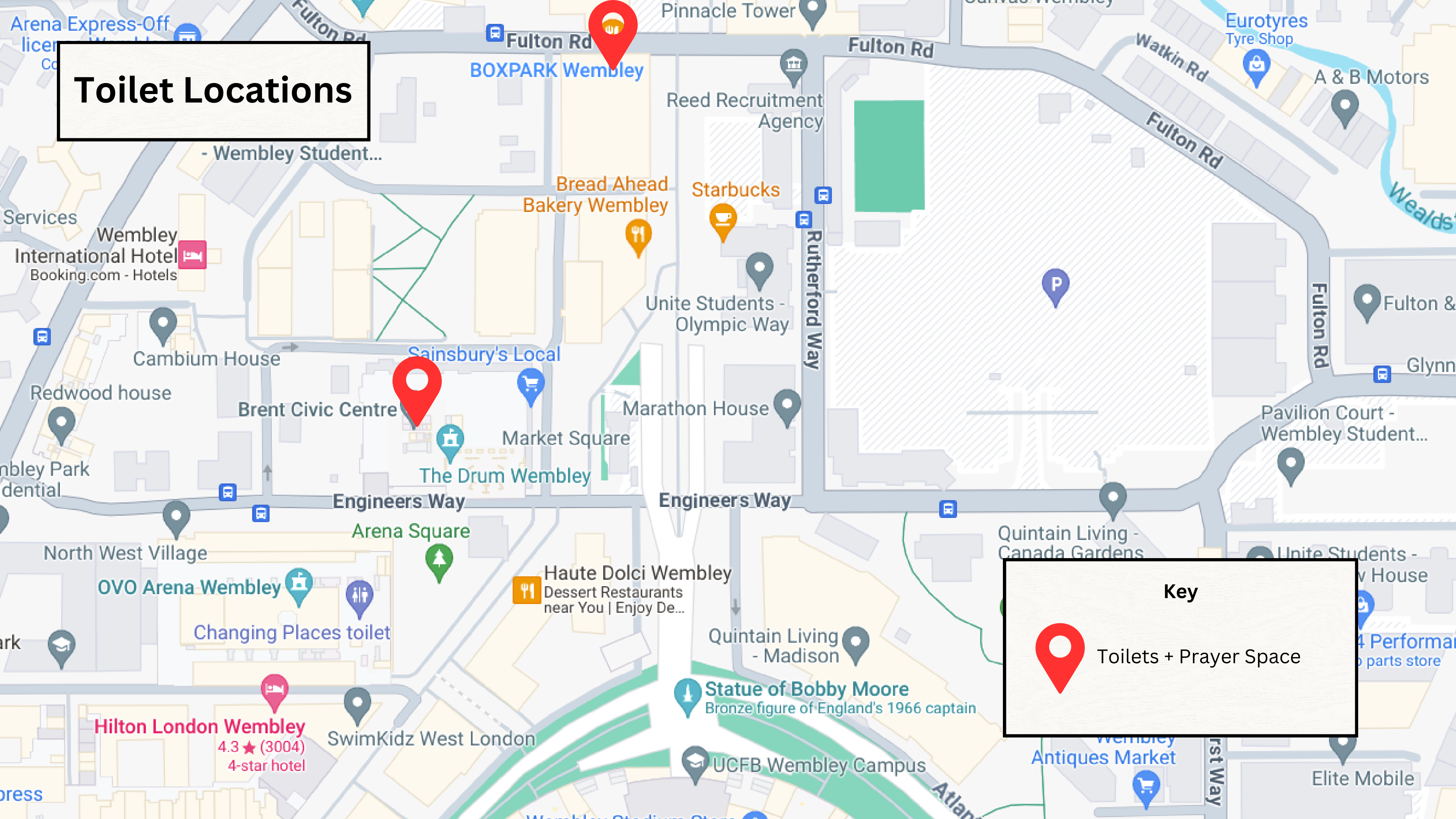


Key

Toilet Locations

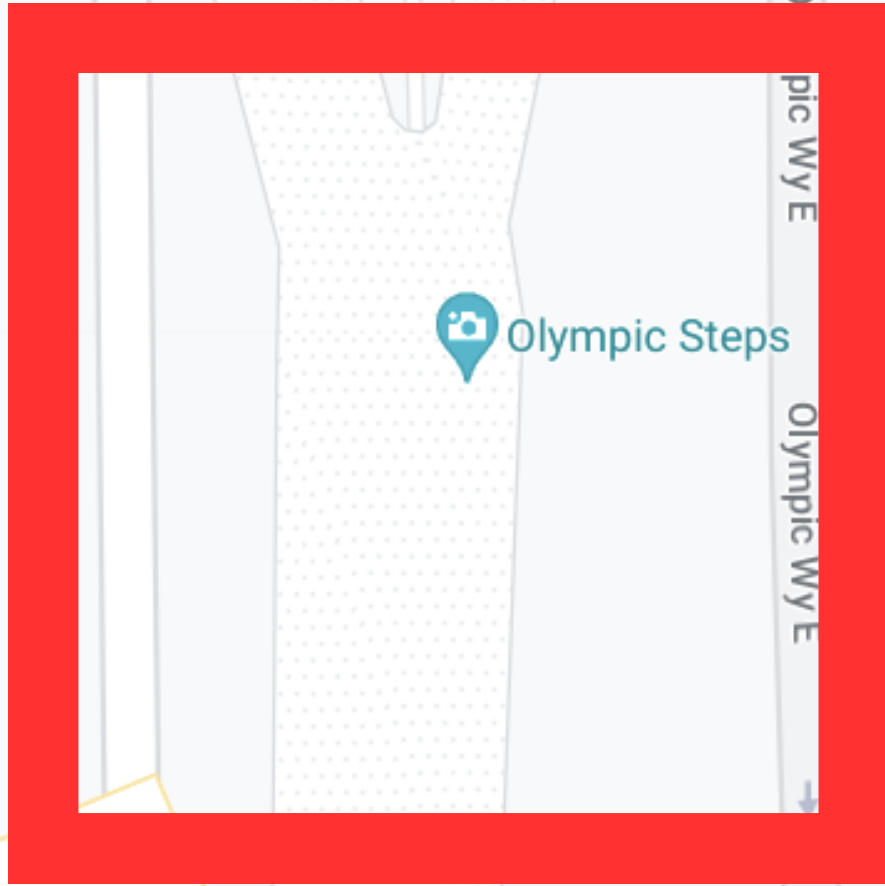
